



easy Mini Zine Folding instructions


Hey there! Let's turn that printout of yours into an awesome mini-zine together. It's really simple – I promise. **Here's how we do it:**











First Step - Folding: Grab your paper with the print side facing up. Fold it in half to make it smaller (that's A5 size now). Smooth out the fold nicely. Repeat this process two times until your paper is tiny (like A7 size).

- 2 Snip, Snap A Cut: Okay, now unfold the paper two times until it's A5 size again. At the fold, you're going to make a cut but only go halfway through.
 - Unfold Everything: Unfold the paper
 back to its original size (A4). You can now see where you've folded and cut.

Hagic Trick Time: Fold the paper lengthwise down the middle and pull the sides together as if you're opening a book. That cut you made creates a sort of gate for you to go through.

5 **Final Folds:** Your zine will almost fold itself into shape now. Just flip the pages so it looks like a tiny book. The cover should be at the front and the end at the back. If the folds need a bit of tidying, go over them with the back of a spoon or your fingernail.

And you're all set! That wasn't hard, right? Now, it's all ready for you to dive into its pages, share with friends, or maybe even leave a few in your favorite spots around town for others to discover. Have fun spreading the creativity and enjoy your mini zine-making journey!

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
